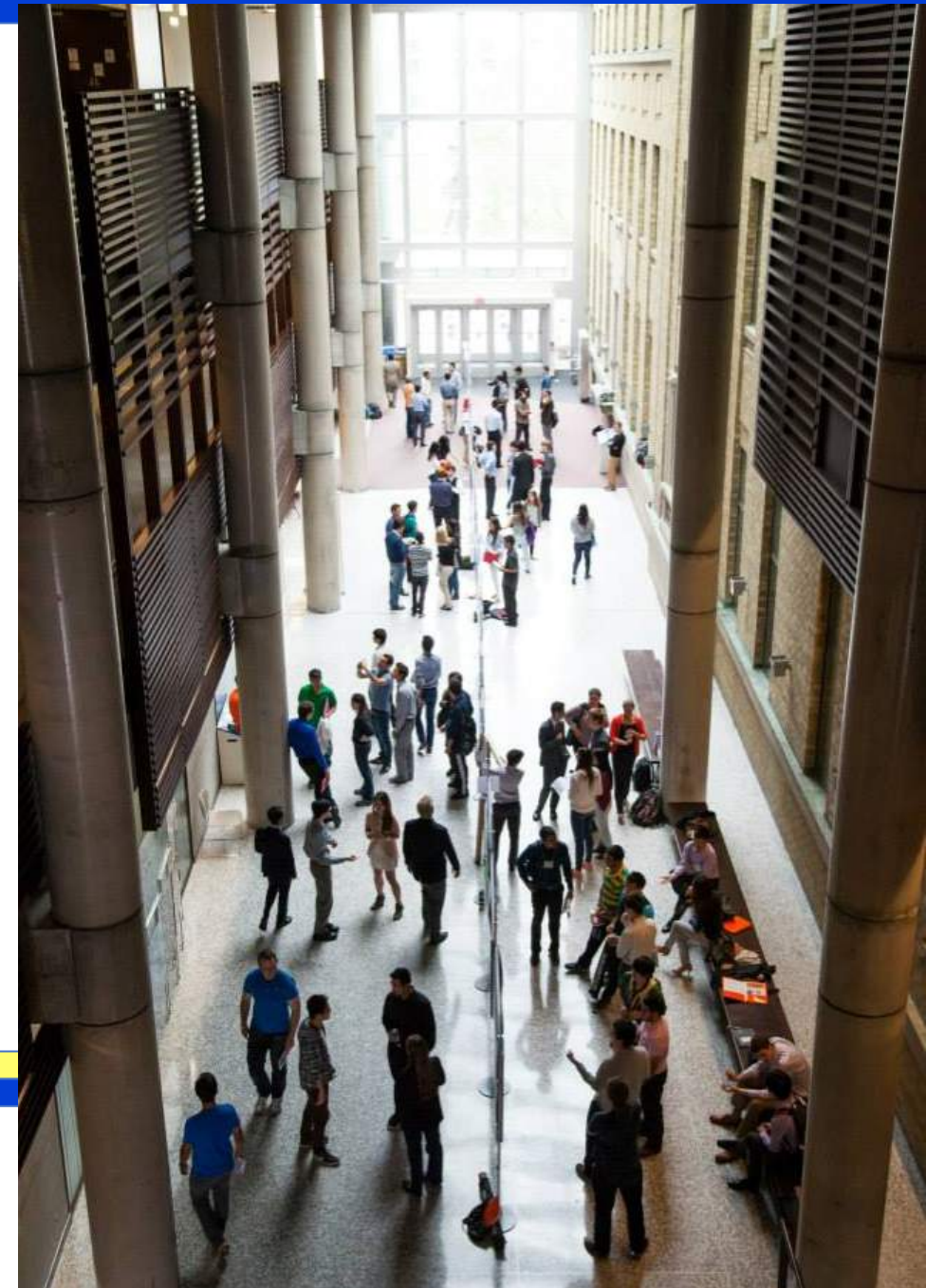
What is UnERD?

- Undergraduate Engineering Research Day, for undergraduate researchers to connect, showcase, and get feedback on their work in the forms of podium or poster presentations.
- Funded by Office of Vice Dean, Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering (APSC)
- 53 podium presenters, 47 poster presenters, 34 judges across 7 categories in UnERD 2016

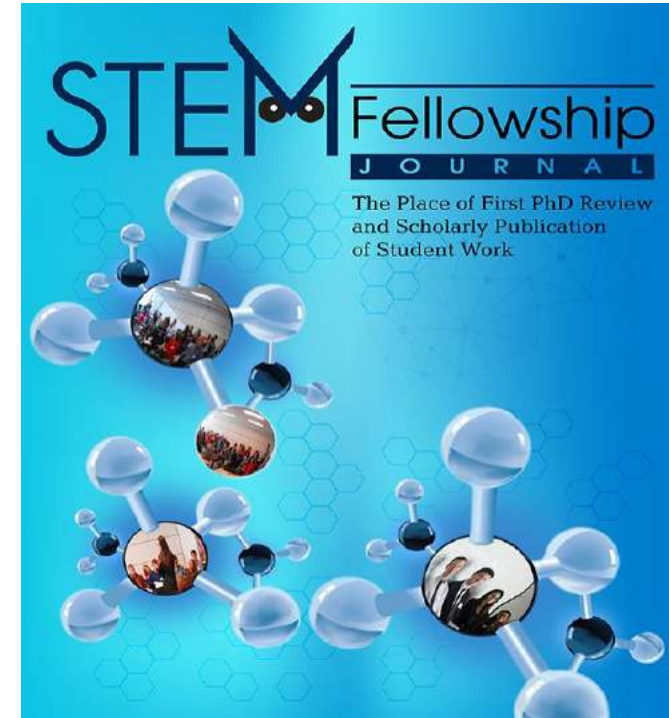


Why should you participate in UnERD?
